



M1 Drogheda Bypass Opening Soon

The Drogheda Bypass will open to traffic on Monday 9th June 2003, removing 15,000 vehicles from Drogheda town centre and greatly improving the environment of the town.

Later this June another 16 km of new motorway will open, from Dublin Airport to Balbriggan. Motorists will then be able to travel on a continuous motorway from Dublin to south of Dundalk saving valuable time on their journeys.

The main toll plaza is 7 km south of Drogheda. We remind motorists to have the toll ready - €1.50 for a car.

Motorists can pay by inserting the correct change into a toll machine or by paying one of the cashiers who can provide change.

Discount cards providing a 10% discount per 20 journeys are available at the toll plaza.

There will be a total of ten toll booths, five in each direction, to ensure traffic moves swiftly through the toll plaza.

If you use the slip roads from the motorway onto or off Donore Road you will pay a toll for use of the motorway and the new Boyne bridge.
