I AM writing to make a complaint about the road closure on the Julianstown to Duleek Road the R150.

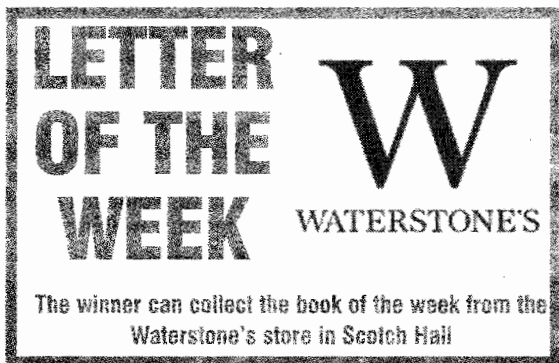
We the residents were told this road would be closed in April 2007, for five months.

It is being used at night as a race track and the residents are really browned off.
